Ask on the frequency if a controller is free to go with you on a short flight. Have him/her handle the radio on your way back in. Enlighten them the way they have enlightened us. Could be fun as well as very valuable.

The recognition that we received for our PAPA Safety and Scholarship Foundation in the publicity for the Rock and Run the Runway 5K was outstanding. The Chicago Executive Airport Board will be donating some of the profits to our fund in the near future. And as the second year for this event—the attendance and participation was much greater than last year—both by the general public and by our own CEPA membership.

On the “needs more work” front is our quest for affordable fuel. We want to support the airport's economic success by more than just the revenue for aircraft storage. The hangars have generated great revenue, but we rarely buy fuel at our home airport because of the cost. If the airport would install a self serve fuel pump for 100LL, we could participate by purchasing affordable fuel. This would be business that is being done OFF AIRPORT now. We WILL keep working, and thanking those who are working with us to accomplish this goal.
